Elementary practices are aimed at ringers who can master a bell and ring in rounds without help. The practice is run along the ART (Association of Ringing Teachers) methodology which is designed to have intermediate steps to help jump the hurdle from rounds to change ringing. Focused practices will concentrate on a particular method each month such as Grandsire Triples, Plain Bob Minor or treble bob methods such as Kent or Oxford. It is aimed at ringers who can plain hunt on the treble and are ready to move on to ringing inside as well as an opportunity to ring methods on 8 bells.

Advanced practices are an opportunity to try methods you may not be able to ring at your home tower e.g. Stedman, Double Norwich and Treble Bob, as well as surprise major methods.

Note: In addition to the above, there is also a general Branch practice on the **3rd Tuesday** of the month from 14.00 - 15.30 at Binfield. Ringers of all standards are welcome.
